Memorial Day commemorates all the women and men who have died while in military service and will be observed this year on May 30, 2022, the last Monday in May as designated by Federal law ([36 U.S.C. 116](#)).

Began in the late 1860's as Decoration Day, spring flowers were distributed at graves to honor those fallen in the Civil War. By the end of the 19th century, ceremonies were being held in cities across the country. In 1966, the Federal Government declared Waterloo, New York, the official birthplace of Memorial Day. [Public Law 106-579](#), signed into law December 28, 2000, designated 3:00 p.m. (local time) on Memorial Day each year as the "National Moment of Remembrance" and created the White House Commission on the National Moment of Remembrance.

Like President Grant in 1873, Presidents have continued to commemorate those who have died in service to the country by visiting Arlington National Cemetery and speaking to the nation.
